DELAWARE CITY DAY

Delaware City Day is approaching quickly!!! It is on **Saturday, July 21, 2012**. Plan on coming out for the 11:00 AM parade and spend the day. After the parade there will be children's entertainment and many vendors. There will also be musical entertainment, and of course the best fireworks in New Castle County will be at dusk! ALL RESIDENTS EAST of FIFTH STREET will need a RESIDENTS' PARKING PERMIT!!! East of Fifth Street will be closed to **ALL traffic after 6:00 PM on Delaware City Day, July 21, 2012 unless you have a parking permit.** If you and your guests are already in town and parked before 6:00 PM you will be fine. Any resident who thinks they will be entering Town after 6:00 PM and driving East of Fifth Street should stop by Town Hall at 407 Clinton Street to obtain a **FREE Parking Permit**. To obtain the parking permit you will need to show the registration card for all vehicles in your household and a parking permit will be issued for all vehicles for free. Without a permit you will not be able to enter the City East of Fifth Street until after the fireworks.

LISTEN: EMERGENCY SIREN... If you hear a steady siren for 3-5 minutes, tune your radio to an Emergency Alert System (EAS) station for information. The following radio stations are a part of the EAS: WDEL 1150AM; WNWK 1260 AM; WWTX 1290AM; WDOV 1410 AM; WILM 1450 AM; WAMS 1600AM; WRDX 92.9FM; WSTW 93.7FM; WDSO 94.7FM; WJBR 99.5FM; WKNZ 88.7FM. Boaters tune to Marine Channel 16. If you do not have access to a radio, call the Delaware Emergency Management Agency at 1-877-SAY-DEMA or 302-659-3362.

FLOOD ELEVATION CERTIFICATE

A [FEMA elevation certificate](http://www.fema.gov) is required for all new construction and "significant improvements" in the flood zone. In addition, no filling or grading may take place within the flood plain without a permit from the City. You can come to Town Hall, 407 Clinton Street, to get an Elevation Certificate application and instructions on how to fill it out or you can visit www.fema.gov. Any resident in need of a copy of the elevation certificate for flood insurance for their residence can check with Town Hall to see if there is one on file prior to contacting an engineer or surveyor.

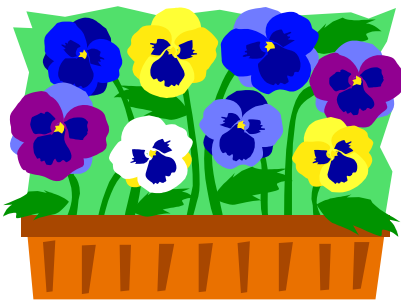
