## Household hazards requiring special handling, disposal

- 1. Insecticides, fungicides and animal care products
- 2. Pesticides, herbicides and wood preservatives
- 3. Fluorescent light bulbs, compact fluorescent lights and other mercury-containing devices (switches, thermometers, thermostats and ballasts), including thermometers and thermostats
- 4. Rechargeable and button batteries
- 5. Photographic chemicals, hobby-set chemicals
- 6. Pool chemicals and ammonium nitrate fertilizers
- 7. Lead and other non-latex paints, paint strippers, rust removers
- 8. Corrosive or caustic cleaners and acids, including battery acids and toilet and drain cleaners
- 9. Flammables, including oil-based paints, solvents, and fuel and fluids for cars, tools and machines
- 10. Very old products that may contain banned or restricted chemicals such as DDT
- 11. Prescription medicines
- 12. Personal care items such as nail polish and removers
- 13. Home aerosols and cleaners, including bleaches
- 14. Ammunition and firecrackers
- 15. Antifreeze
