CITY SERVICES

As the situation with the coronavirus continues to develop, the team at Town Hall remains committed to provide services to our residents and business community. You rely on us every day for public safety as well as essential city services. We will continue to provide those services as effectively and efficiently as possible.

POLICE SERVICES

In the event of an emergency, call 911 immediately. If you have a non-emergency requiring police services, call the non-emergency number at (302)573-2800. If you have general questions for the Police Department, please call (302)836-6344. There will be no public access to the police department until further notice.

THE DELAWARE CITY COMMUNITY CENTER (LIBRARY, SENIOR CENTER, REEDY POINT PLAYERS, DELAWARE CITY PAL).

To help control the spread of the coronavirus, beginning Monday, March 16, 2020, the Delaware City Community Center will be closed for two weeks.

PAYMENTS FOR CITY SERVICES (INCLUDING WATER/PERMITS)

We are taking multiple steps to minimize health risks to our team, our customers and our community, which include enhanced cleaning procedures for Town Hall and the Delaware City Community Center. In addition, we will be limiting public access to Town Hall. We are requiring anyone that needs the services of Town Hall staff to contact us at (302)834-4573 to schedule an appointment.

Payments for city services can be made with a debit or credit card on line or by calling Town Hall. Anyone wishing to make a payment by check or money order may drop their payment off at Town Hall by inserting it through a mail slot in the lobby area.
