## **Significant Events**

- On April 5, 2018, the Delaware City Police Department investigated the theft of a package taken from a door step in the 300 block of Madison Street. The contents were recovered by another resident.
- On April 7, 2018 The Delaware City Police Department investigated a criminal mischief to the Artesian Water Company pump house located at Ft. DuPont. The windows were broken with a rock.
- On April 8<sup>th</sup>, the Delaware City Police Department responded to an altercation in Lewinski's Restaurant involving two Delaware City residents. One of the individuals was charged with assault in the third degree in connection with the incident.
- On April 13<sup>th</sup>, the Delaware City Police Department and a Delaware City Fire Department Ambulance responded to a unit in Hamilton Place for a drug overdose. The individual was transported to the Christiana hospital where she was treated and released.
- On April 17<sup>th</sup>, the Delaware City Police Department responded to a domestic incident in the Delaware City Mobile Home Park. An individual was charged with criminal mischief and terroristic threatening in connection with this incident.

- On April 24<sup>th</sup>, the Delaware City Police Department investigated a burglary that occurred in the 200 block of Washington Street. As a result of the investigation and an alert neighbor, we have obtained arrest warrants for an individual responsible for the burglary. The warrants will be executed in the next couple of days as the person in currently being held at the Howard Young Correctional Facility.
- On April 24<sup>th</sup>, the Delaware City Police investigated a shoplifting and theft at Crabby Dick's restaurant. As a result of that investigation, three individuals have been identified and arrested in connection with this incident.
- On April 28<sup>th</sup>, the Delaware City Police Department and a Delaware City Fire Company ambulance responded to Hamilton Place for a drug overdose. The individual was transported to the Christiana Hospital where she was treated. This was the same individual that overdosed on April 13<sup>th</sup>.
