Crime Information:

Saturday, 1/12/2019 – Resisting Arrest – DCPD responded to the Delaware City Mobile Home Park to investigate a domestic in progress. During the investigation, we learned that Paul Wade, 26, of the Mobile Home Park was wanted on a capias. Mr. Wade fled on foot from the Delaware City officer. After an extensive search of the area, Mr. Wade was apprehended by a Delaware City Police Officer. He was charged with resisting arrest and the outstanding court capias.

Saturday, 1/19/2019 – Criminal trespassing – Sometime between 5:00 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. an unknown subject was found inside one of the boats stored in the storage yard at the Delaware City Marina. The subject fled on foot prior to the arrival of police.

Thursday, 1/31/2019 – Home Invasion - Sometime around 1130 p.m., two individuals forced their way into a trailer in the Delaware City Mobile Home Park. Our preliminary investigation leads us to believe this maybe drug related. However, this incident remains under active investigation.

General Information

The Delaware City Police Department has recently completed the installation of the in-car camera system in four of the department's patrol fleet. The in-car camera system was paid for through a grant from the Delaware Department of Justice.
