Significant Events

- On March 5, 2018, The Delaware City Police Department responded to a criminal nuisance complaint that occurred in an apartment in the 100 block of Clinton Street. The complaint stemmed from the complainant reporting the burning and smell of marijuana that traveled into their building.

- On March 29, 2018, the Delaware City Police Department responded to the Post Office in reference to a disorderly subject complaint in the lobby. An investigation into the incident led to charges being placed against a 43 year old Delaware City woman for disorderly conduct.
