Crime Information:

- ➤ Friday, 3/1/2019 DCPD investigated an assault that occurred in the Delaware City Mobile Home Park. Najee Chambers, 21, of the unit block of Cole Boulevard, Middletown, was charged with assault in the third degree after he became involved in a physical altercation with a 17 year old Delaware City resident.
- > The DCPD investigated seven (7) thefts from motor vehicles during the month of March.

- > The DCPD investigated two suspected illegal drug overdoses during the month of March.
- Two Delaware City juveniles were arrested in connection with thefts from motor vehicles that occurred during the month of March. The two boys were charged with burglary, conspiracy and theft of a firearm. Those charges stem from an incident that occurred on March 31st near the Delaware City Marina. In that incident the juveniles stole a semi-automatic weapon from inside of a vehicle. Both boys were released to the custody of their parents pending a trial in The Family Court at a later date.

- Section 26-22 Curfew for Minors Under Eighteen Generally It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of eighteen (18) years to loiter, idle, wander, stroll or play in or remain unnecessarily upon the public streets, highways, roads, alleys, parks, playgrounds, wharves, docks or other public grounds, public places and public buildings, places of amusement and entertainment, vacant lots or other unsupervised places, whether by foot or in a motor vehicle or other conveyance between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M., of the following day, official city time; provided, however, that the provisions of this Section shall not apply to a minor accompanied by his parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor, or where the minor is upon an emergency errand or legitimate employment directed by his parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor.
