Crime Information:

- > The DCPD investigated a theft of lights from the African Union Church Cemetery sometime between October 29th and November 2nd this year. Our investigation led to the arrest of Harry W. Stouffer, 74, of the Delaware City Mobile Home Park. He was charged theft and criminal mischief in connection with the incident.
- On November 28th, the DCPD investigated a fraud that occurred sometime between November 26th and November 28th. That investigation revealed that an individual, identifying himself as a computer repairman, befriended the elderly victim via the telephone. That business friendship led to the repairman gaining computer access to the victim's bank accounts. It also led the victim obtaining various gift cards and giving that information to the repairman. The case is still under investigation.

Announcements

- DCPD urges all citizens to be careful and not to allow individuals access to your bank accounts or to provide any individual that you do not know any personal information about yourself online or via the telephone. There are multiple scams currently active in the area.
- DCPD reminds all residents to lock their cars when not in use. Several neighborhoods in the Bear and New Castle areas have seen an increase in thefts from vehicles.
- The Delaware City Christmas Parade has been rescheduled and will be this Saturday, December 22, 2018.
