Significant Events for October

The Delaware City Police Department investigated an assault that took place in the unit block of Clinton Street on Tuesday evening October 10, 2017 sometime around midnight. The incident wasn't reported for almost twelve hours later. The incident is still under investigation and both parties are familiar with each other.

The Delaware City Police Department investigated a home invasion in the 300 block of Washington Street on Thursday, October 26, 2017. As a result of our investigation, Jessica Lynn Harvey and Charles Fletcher, both of New Castle were arrested on numerous charges including burglary, aggravated assault, unlawful imprisonment and a weapons charge.

The Delaware City Police Department was awarded \$3,216.26 for drug enforcement and was awarded \$3,501.68 for overtime and various community relations programs from the State.

On Sunday, November 20, 2017, members of the Delaware City Police Department and the DE-MOLA(the Masonic Organization located at 4th and Clinton Street) delivered Thanksgiving dinners to twenty families in Delaware City. We would like to thank Councilwoman Barrett for her assistance with this program.

The Delaware City Police Department is actively looking for Kevin S. Magaw. Mr. Magaw is wanted for the sexual assault of a child under the age of 13. We are asking anyone with knowledge of his whereabouts to contact Crime Stoppers at 1-800-TIP-3333 or 911.
