Significant Events for September

The City of Delaware City was just named the 7th safest city in the state of Delaware. Delaware City was named in a report released under "The SafeWise Report" which produces this report in the month of September each year.

To quote a statement in the report, "Representing the best of Delaware, every city on this year's list also made the cut last year – which is a good indication that community leaders, law enforcement officers and residents remain vigilant about safety."

The Delaware City Police Department was awarded \$12, 460.68 in a grant from the state. This is from the Fund to Combat Violent Crimes.
